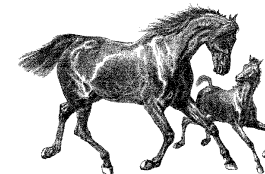

RULES and CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All competitors (except Gymkhana and Clear Round) must wear a number which will be provided.
2. All horses and ponies in ridden classes must be four years and over.
3. **No refund of entry fees can be made once entry is accepted.**
4. **No entries can be taken once the class is closed.**
5. Hard hats of approved current BSI standard **MUST** be worn with 3 point harness at all times.
6. In all showjumping classes, jackets should be worn and back protectors are optional.
7. Winners will be given Rosettes in the ring but must collect and sign for Challenge Cups from the Secretary's tent.
8. All Challenge Cups **must** be returned in accordance with the signed form.
9. Children's Birth Certificates and Equine Passports are to be produced if required. Age of children as on day of the Show.
10. The Judge's decision is final.
11. Objections only taken in writing with £25 deposit within 15 minutes of end of class, returnable if objection upheld.
12. Canterng outside of the rings is not allowed except in the designated warm up area and lunging is not permitted anywhere on the showground.
13. Stallions/colts must be bitted adequately and under control and not exhibited by anyone under the age of 14 years.
14. Horses and ponies are not allowed in the Marquee / Stalls area.
15. No training shoes, whips or spurs allowed in Gymkhana.
16. All dogs to be kept on lead at all times.
17. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, withhold a prize or disqualify a competitor at any time or for any reason they may deem reasonable.
18. The Organisers reserve the right to postpone or cancel the Show, or to make amendments or alterations to Classes for any reason they may deem necessary.
19. The Organisers or Land Owner accept no responsibility or liability for loss or damages incurred by any Competitor or Spectator to themselves or their property.
